

## REGULAR GIVING

There are two ways in which to commit to giving regularly to St John's:

### **By Standing Order:**

Our preferred way for people to give is by monthly standing order. The bills need paying on a regular basis throughout the year and so regular monthly income is the most helpful in managing the cashflow. However, for some people their own financial circumstances make quarterly, six monthly, or annual standing orders more suitable for them.

This choice can be made when you either set up such a standing order yourself, via internet banking, or by completing **this (insert link) Form**. St John's bank details are on the form.

### **By joining our Envelope Scheme**

We offer weekly or monthly envelopes which can be used on their own, if this is the most suitable way for you to give regularly, or you might like a set to run alongside your regular bank standing order, so that a 'token of your whole financial commitment' goes up to the alter to be blessed at the main Sunday Services. If you are not in church every week you can put the envelopes for the missed weeks into the offering when next you are able to attend. There is space to request weekly or monthly envelopes at the foot of the Gift Aid Declaration (see below)

### **Gift Aid Declaration**

The government encourages those of us who pay Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax to allow the charities to which we donate money to recover the tax we have already paid on our gift. In order for St John's to reclaim this tax (currently £1 for every £4 given, so that a gift of £20 is worth £25 to St John's.
