The **Sunday School**, for children of school age, meet during our main Sung Eucharist, when there are also crèche facilities available as well as activities for toddlers.

Some of our Activities

Sceptics meets monthly after the Sung Eucharist to discuss challenging issues arising from the day's readings and sermon.

The **Growth Group** meets monthly on a Friday evening, beginning with a simple shared meal, to discuss contemporary affecting our faith.

The **Lone Parents Group** meets regularly to offer one another support and share experiences.

The **Walking Groups** organize monthly walks on Saturdays and Thursdays of varying difficulty - an opportunity to walk and talk together in the countryside.

Scottish Country Dancing takes place in the church hall each Sunday evening after Evensong.

The **Choir** sing at three services each Sunday and meet each Thursday to rehearse.

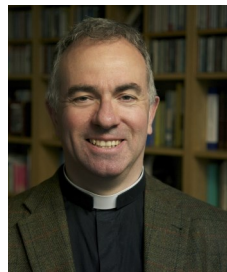
Three **Book Groups** meet on a monthly basis in different members' homes to discuss their current choice of reading.

The **Gardening Group** meet regularly to work on the church grounds.

The **Social Committee** organize a range of activities throughout the year aimed specifically at providing opportunities for us to meet together in a social context.
